PRIVILEGE FROM THE FLOOR: Bill Nivison, Transfer Site Operator, reported to the Ledyard Town Board that there is a family identified as renting property from Bruce Driscoll on Levanna Road that has been dumping trash into the compactor during the week when the Transfer Site is closed. They leave a mess as the compactor is left overflowing with trash bags, and Bill has been going to the Transfer Site to clean it up during mid-week.

Bill said he has spoken to property owner Bruce Driscoll about it. Supervisor Mark Jordan said it will be remedied.

Councilman Paul Hilliard mentioned that it might be helpful to have a list of what can be dumped into the compactor. Bill said that the hauler, We Care only states that electronics are not allowed.

Clean-Up Day this year at the Transfer Site is July 18, 2015.

Bill asked when the repairs on the Transfer Site building are scheduled to be done. Mark Jordan said he would let him know.

Bill also said he may be interested in volunteering to work on the Town website.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Councilman Jim Frisch asked Supervisor Mark Jordan to call the Association of Towns regarding the stones in the Town of Ledyard right of way issue at the Bruck Mosher property.

Mark reported to the Town Board that resident Bruck Mosher has moved the stones back away from the road right of way just a little bit. Councilman Dan Green would like to do something proactive towards getting the stones moved out of the right of way.

Councilman John Binns said that Genoa has put some of their records in digital form. He suggested that the Town Board may want to have someone come to talk with them about doing the same for the Town of Ledyard.
