HIGHWAY

- Councilman Binns addressed Highway Superintendent in regards to quality of mowing. It was stated that Ron Smith was helping the Highway Dept. with mowing as he is also a wingman in the winter. Councilman Binns wants Superintendent Arnold to confirm with the insurance company and the Civil Service Office that this is in compliance.
