PRIVILEGE FROM THE FLOOR: C.C. Legislator Keith Batman gave the Town Board an update on the Broadband project. It is projected to be up and running within 6-9 months.

APPROVE MINUTES: On motion by Jim Frisch, seconded by Dan Green, the Minutes for March 2014 were approved as submitted.

APPROVE REPORTS: On motion by Jim Frisch, seconded by John Binns, the Supervisor, Clerk and Code Officer reports were approved as submitted.

SUNSET BEACH ICE DAMAGE: Ledyard Code Officer Brian Hicks appeared before the Town Board to discuss the recent ice damage on Sunset Beach Rd. that destroyed approximately fifteen docks. Councilman John Binns suggested that a flyer be put on each doorway to inform residents that if they have a structure that was damaged and needs repair, they need to get a building permit before they rebuild. The permit fee will be waived for new work, but only if there is a legitimate permit on file for the structure when it was originally built.

There was also discussion regarding revising the Ledyard Zoning Code.

HIGHWAY REPORT: Superintendent Jim Bailey reported that he advertised the old mower for sale and got no response. The new mower is here.

PAY BILLS: On motion by Jim Frisch, seconded by John Binns, the bills on abstract #004; 72-93; A=\$9,644.94; B=\$660.93; DA=\$0; DB=\$12,840.47 were approved for payment.

VOTE: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays

TRANSFER FUNDS: On motion by Jim Frisch, seconded by John Binns, a transfer from the Justice Account A1110.4 in the amount of \$53.83 (for bank checks wrongly withdrawn by the Cayuga Lake National Bank from an account designated for court fees) to the Justice account designated only for paying court fees to NY State was approved.
