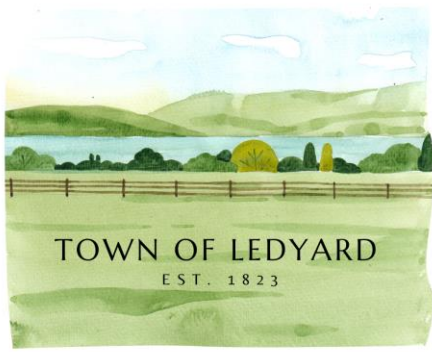
PLEDGE-REMEMBER TROOPS

Supervisor Jordan called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for our troops at 7:30 pm.

PRIVILEGE FROM THE FLOOR

CLPP - Cayuga Lake Protection Plan, Carl Rindfleisch presented the sewer project and explained to the board what a Bond of Anticipation means. They are intending on applying for funding in June. The decision should be known in December. This will then make it easier to break down how much residents will have to pay. Rindfleisch would like to see this run from Honoco Rd. down to Cayuga/Tompkins County Line. They are currently anticipating a 5 million upgrade to sewer treatment plant along with running the water lines. After the amount per resident is calculated, it will then go to a referendum for the public to vote. This is for sewer only, not water. The Village of Aurora is in favor of this. This is approximately a \$35 million project. Rindfleisch would like to see the change in the voting system. Currently only registered voters in the district can vote but they would like to try to have it as all taxpayers have the right to vote. Honoco Rd. is mainly a seasonal area with registered voters registered in their hometowns, not their summer homes. Long Point State Park would be connected to this as well. A letter of support may be requested for the future.

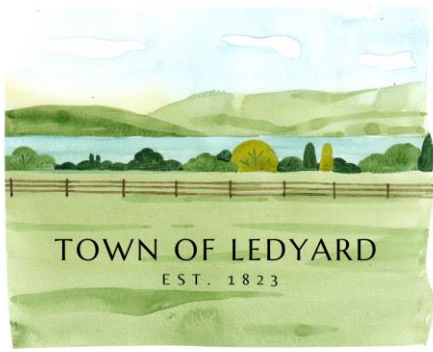

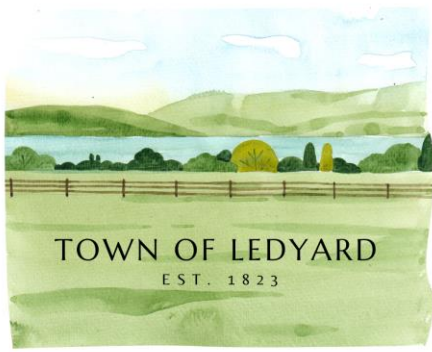
