PLEDGE-REMEMBER TROOPS

Supervisor Jordan called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for our troops at 7:30 pm.

John LaGorga, PE from MRB Group Project Overview:

The Cayuga County Water and Sewer Authority has hired the MRB Group to design a new sewage collection system along the east shore of the lake, from just south of the village of Aurora to the Tompkins County line. MRB Group will size and layout the sewage collection system and estimate the total project costs and cost per resident. The scope of work includes replacing each holding tank or septic tank with a new tank, grinder pump, and control panel with alarms. The pump will transfer sewage into a small diameter force main, generally placed under Honoco Road and Sunset Beach Drive.

Sewer District Formation:

Cayuga County plans to form a new sewer district but acknowledges the significant cost of the sewage collection system. They are not interested in finalizing the sewer district without securing grant money. The new sewer district can be formed in one of two ways: Permissive Referendum: Forms the sewer district and only requires a vote if residents in the district petition for one.

Mandatory Referendum: Requires a vote to form the sewer district.

Discussion Points:

Voting eligibility was discussed. According to state and county law, only residents who own property in the district and are registered to vote in Cayuga County may vote. The Town expressed concerns to MRB about the fairness of property owners impacted by the project not being able to vote. MRB stated they would communicate this concern to the Cayuga County Water and Sewer Authority.

Discussed Air B&B – change assessment for properties just renting for 4 months along Honoco Rd to Commercial? Mark will ask town lawyer
