PLEDGE-REMEMBER TROOPS

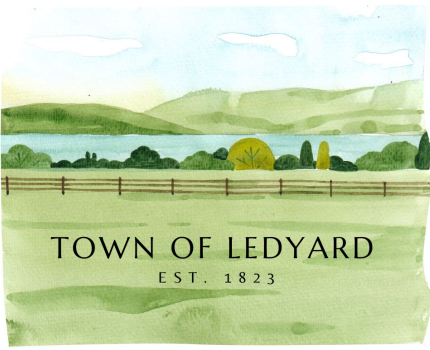
Supervisor Jordan called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for our troops at 7:30 pm.

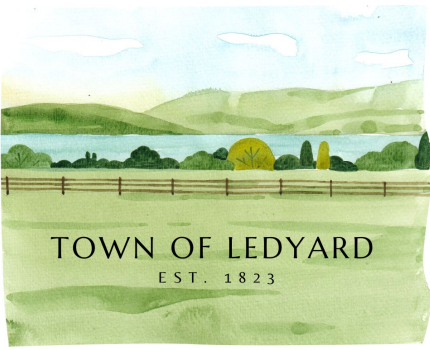

HIGHWAY Dept.

Supervisor Jordan told Arnold that Nivison wanted gates at transfer site done. Arnold stated Nivison had to be patient. Nivison told Arnold he will need to pick up trash at the transfer site. Entrance door and garage door need to be renovated. The Highway Superintendent would like to get some bids. Paving carpenter rd. All other chipping is almost done. Steve still working on pricing trucks

OLD BUSINESS | NEW BUSINESS

Supervisor Jordan stated that he did not sign the Sewer Project Letter as he felt no one went through the proper channels. No one came from Honoco or Sunset Beach to the Town Board asking for sewer. We are told, "It Will Save Cayuga Lake"? How do they know if a \$40million, \$50million project (amount continues to increase) will save the lake? Supervisor Jordan believes that each holding tank along the lank should be dye tested prior. This will put an additional \$11-\$15 on each person's tax bill who lives in that area and they all should have the right to vote on it. Supervisor Jordan thinks the LS District will struggle with the increase. The sewage plant in the Village needs about \$5million in upgrades as it is. This will be an expensive experiment that may not work. The Assessor stated that the assessment will increase around \$20k due to sewer Cayuga County Health Dept never came to the Town and spoke of any problems or concerns.

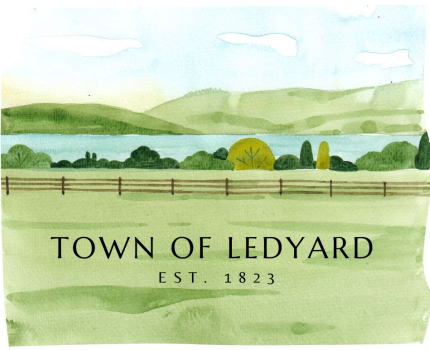
