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CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

There is a problem on Honoco Rd. regarding a dock extension that is infringing on the neighbor's property setback line. Code Enforcement Officer, Dan Green went down several times to talk to the resident. Supervisor Jordan gave a stop work order stating he needed to get a permit, drawings etc. Green issued an appearance ticket today (09/12/2022). Resident will appear in court on October 11, 2022. The resident from Honoco stated he received a permit from DEC and the Army Corp. of Engineer. Supervisor Jordan stated he confirmed today that he did NOT receive authorization from either the Army Corp. of Engineers or the DEC.

Dan Green has handed in a letter of resignation for the Town of Ledyard Zoning Officer. Mr. Green wants to stay with the Town of Ledyard as a code enforcement office but not a zoning officer. Brian Hicks will come in to help until the town can fill the position. Supervisor Jordan said that the town will not have two separate positions. Brian Hicks will fill the position on a temporary basis until the position is filled. Mr. Hicks will be doing both positions.

Arnold will sell current road tires that the new truck came with and have the asking price of \$300/tire.

Highway Superintendent Arnold discussed the plowing contract between Cayuga County and the town. Once Supervisor Jordan receives the plow contract, he will call the board members to inform them of the contract specifics once they are received.
